### **UKIAH SPEEDWAY ANNOUNCES 2010 SCHEDULE**

**Ukiah, California..... Ukiah Speedway has released the 2010 schedule for its quarter- mile paved oval located at the fairgrounds in Ukiah, California.**

**The points season for modifieds, bombers, street stocks, legends cars and bandoleros begins on April 3 and ends on August 28. The modifieds will run a 15-event points season, the bombers will have 17 points races, the street stocks will be running 12 times, legends cars 14 times and the bandoleros 15 times. The annual "Playday" practice session will precede the season on Sunday, March 28.**

**Special events in 2010 include the Legends of the Pacific on May 1 and July 31, and the Nor-Cal Hardtops once a month. The popular Pro-4 modifieds visit the speedway six times with their first appearance on April 17. The fast-growing Airport Auto Brokers Late Models are scheduled to compete on April 17, June 26, August 14, and September 11.**

**Specialty shows for 2010 include a best appearing car contest, three motor home jumps, motor home races, slider races, kid's rides and boat races. Fireworks and a demolition derby are planned for July 3. All event dates will be listed on the printed schedule.**

**For the first time in 8 years Ukiah Speedway management has elected not to run auto races during the summer holidays. This will give the drivers and their families an opportunity to spend time together on the Memorial Day weekend, the July 4th weekend, and the Labor Day holiday.**

**The only post-season event will be the annual Bomber Bash, boat race and slider race on September 11. This will be in conjunction with the final points race for the Airport Auto Brokers late model series and the pro-4 modifieds.**
